We invite you to turn off your cell phone and head on a journey through the unspoiled nature of Gorenja Kanomlja. Stop the time and enjoy colourful wildflower meadows where silence is interrupted only by birds chirping, bees buzzing and stream burbling. Vast woodlands provide shelter to a variety of wild animals, such as deers, stags, chamois, as well as lynxes and bears.

Listen to the sound of nature.

This journey is nine kilometres long and will take between two and three hours, depending on your pace.

Along the way, visit the mineral and fossil collection by Janez Klemenčič, the Kanomlja klavže, the 40m high Ovčjak waterfall, the Šturmajce homestead, smithy Pr' Ivaniš, fruit drying stillhouse at the Zaklavže farm and the apiary with honey bee garden and trees.




